This award is a 3-inch diameter multi-colored patch worn as temporary insignia on the right pocket. It may be earned more than once by doing items not done previously, or by repeating items marked with an asterisk\*. The award may be earned as a Cub Scout and again as a Boy Scout for wear on each uniform. Please complete this form by marking the date that points were earned in each category. 100 points total required for each award. Points may be earned from any or all categories. There is no time restriction; a requirement may have been completed any time in the past. Awarded to both youth and adult registered members. Form must be signed by the unit leader and forwarded to the Pine Tree Council office, which will mail a certificate. The 3-inch International Activity Patch (#00144), the 5-inch International Activity Jacket Patch (#00145), and the International Activity Neckerchief (#00746) may be purchased from the Scout Shop.

**CATEGORY I (20 points each)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Participate in Jamboree-on-the-Air or Jamboree on the Internet.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Participate in an international theme program at a pack, troop, or crew meeting.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Participate in a BSA event with a World Brotherhood theme.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Visit a foreign embassy or an international organization (like the World Bank or the OAS) and learn more about what they do.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Conduct an international project such as UNICEF, United Nations Day, etc.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Collect international Scout badges, pins, or Scouts on Stamps and display your collection at a troop or pack meeting.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Organize a collection of money for Scouting's World Friendship Fund.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Earn the Cub Scout or Boy Scout World Conservation Award.

**CATEGORY II (40 points each)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Earn the Interpreter Strip (must be for a different language, if repeated).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Earn or counsel the Citizenship in the World merit badge.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Earn the Cub Scout Language and Culture Academic Belt Loop and Pin.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*As an individual, visit a Scout group or an international Scout Camp in another country.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Host a Scout or Scouter from another country (at least 1 day and 1 night).

**CATEGORY III (60 points each)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Attend a World Jamboree or a Scouting event in another country or participate in a BSA-sponsored Scouting tour in another country.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Serve as a counselor or staff member at an international Scout Camp.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*Cub Scouts: Be able to converse in a foreign language (must be for a different language, if repeated).
