HOW TO REGISTER!

Webelos Leaders

Provisional Scout

Use the 2011 Webelos Provisional Scout Reservation form located at www.camphinds.org to save your spot!

PTC REFUND POLICY

Individuals or groups that cancel a program reservation 30 days prior to the date of the event will receive a refund of fees paid less a 15% administrative charge.

No refunds will be made after the 30-day cancellation period.

MEDICAL FORMS

In order to keep in compliance with the BSA and State of Maine regulations, all Scouts and Leaders attending resident camp must have a completed BSA medical form on file with the camp health office while in camp.

It is a regulation of the Boy Scouts of America that anyone who does not have a completed and signed medical form at the check-in time at camp will not be allowed to remain in camp. *No exceptions will be made.*

CAMPERSHIPS

Camperships: A limited amount of campership funds are available to help those Scouts who could not attend summer camp without financial assistance. To apply for a 2011 campership, families should complete the 2011 PTC Campership Application and return to PTC by **April 1st**. All families will be notified after that date of a possible campership acceptance. Generally only partial camperships are given out except in extreme conditions.
